**Minutes agreed for Emergency meeting Held 23/1/2020**

1)**Planning permission** for 07/2019/1001 Tyfos ,Rural enterprise building (David Williams not present during discussion) all councillors approved

2)**Open Funded grant application re Outdoor gym equipment associated planning permission**  
associated costs of insertion of equipment and impact on the budget these being Planning permission,maintenance , post installation inspection ,annual inspection ,and maintenance .Also responsibility for the weekly inspection .Extra equipment for the Sports field and a suggestion for benches in the cemetery

Council rejected the idea of out door gym equipment there was a concern expressed about usage of such equipment .

Play area

They were informed that Clerk had met with the council and representative of the Play Company on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2019 that the proposal was to insert a new swing for older children which was the most popular choice.That there was the option for a basket swing that the springers could be moved if wanted ,I had informed the council that if there was room they should be retained .The play company gave a quote for new rockers and a swing barrier.The Council expressed that they

wished to have the basket swing along with the flat swing combination ,new springers and a swing barrier.

They wanted to further explore the expansion of the Park (I have included this in the application for open funding grant should any part of the application be rejected ,then we look into the expansion again with the County Council Michael Bennion (.Clerks concern is that the expansion would impede on the picnic tables and also the foot print of equipment and safety matting means that the insertion of new equipment might be minimal,Without stating the obvious the parks area is small a)

Mini goals for the Llandrillo Sports and Social club and a movable pic nic bench for the field ((Sports field used by all members of the public Carnival ,Youth Club ) Benches for the field and also 2 for the Cemetery.
