Before the meeting commenced, a moment's silence was held to remember Mr Dafydd Jones, Syrior, a former Llandrillo Committee Councillor who died recently. Our condolences were sent to the family.

3. **MINUTES OF LAST MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 1st, 2019**

4. **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

- **Westcotec** – an estimate of solar powered signs were received. Ask if there are any negotiations in the price.

5. **CORRESPONDENCE**

- **Rhos Helyg Path** a letter received from Richard Lewis verifying acceptance of letter and his objection to the application submitted by the residents of Rhos Helyg.
- **Hananeel Chapel** – a letter received by a chapel member asking for a contribution towards the repainting of the chapel and railings. It was decided not to contribute at this time.

9. **MATTERS FROM THE COMMUNITY**

- **The Old School Building Project** – An open meeting has been organised for Tuesday, 5th March to show the feasibility plans created by Arcadis. The School Project committee informed the community council that they will be arranging a meeting with the councillors to discuss the Business Plan that they are in the Process

of compiling, and introducing the possibility of the community council to take over the responsibility of the Old School Building.

- **School Drains** – it was reported that the state of the drains on the school grounds are very bad, and need to look into who's responsibility they are.
- **Gwenda Owen**, the former head teacher here in Llandrillo has passed away recently. The clerk to write a letter of condolences to the family on behalf of the Community council.
- **Sewage** – it came to the council's attention that sewage is feeding back to premises at the lower part of the village. Clerk to contract Welsh Water. Also to ask what is the capacity of the current sewage works.
- **Water Supply** – there have been problems with the supply of water to the village recently because of the state of the pipes. Clerk to contract Welsh Water.
- **Eisteddfod yr Urdd Sir Ddinbych 2020 Appeal** – a Dafydd Iwan concert has been arranged for 20th September at the Ganolfan towards raising monies for the appeal.
- **4x4 Vehicles and Motor Bikes**– have created a nuisance lately. Chair has reported this to the Police.
- **Parking at Rhoslan** – is a worry. County Council are looking into demolishing the garages to create more parking spaces.
- T Butterworth noted the state of the **Bus Stops and Phone box** in the village. The bus stops are regularly cleaned by the County Council. Clerk to contact BT regarding the Telephone Box.
- A member of the community has been on the list for a bungalow at Llandrillo. She has been offered two premises at Cynwyd, but she has refused these as she prefers to be near to family in Llandrillo. She has now been removed from the list because of 22 refusals. Mabon to look into the matter.
- **Tree at Bro Dinam** – concern regarding a dying tree on the estate. Clerk to contract County Council.
- The tarmac in front of **Godre'r Berwyn** has been noted as needing repairs. Work hopefully to be done soon.
- **Lights on the Wern** (next to playground) not working. Clerk to contact County Council.
- **Road to Berwyn Mountains** – Fallen fence/landslide following bad weather. Clerk to contract Till Hill
- **Hendwr** – the smell from the Methane Digester is worse at times.
- **Hendwr** – need to look into planning permission for work going ahead at the moment.
- **Dinam Road** – parts of road have eroded badly - Clerk to contract county Council
