3. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING HELD FRIDAY MAY 20th, 2019

Minutes were accepted as true, and signed by the Chair, Eira Lewis.

4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

- **Hendwr Caravan Park** – an e-mail was received from Adam Turner, Denbighshire stating that there were no more caravans than the number permitted, although the foundations of some caravans had been moved. The Authority will not take any further action in this regard.
However, the caravan park breaches condition 8 of planning permission 07/2014/0366 / PF, that an owner should give a flood warning on the site. They were given 4 months to meet these requirements.
No report was received regarding the use of the Methane Digester
- **Placement of Ysgol Bro Dyfrdwy Pupils** - Since the last meeting, emails were sent to the local MP and AM, and a reply was received confirming their acceptance. Ken Skates is looking into the matter with Denbighshire, and will report back to us once he has had a response.
Mabon added that he had a meeting with the head teacher of Ysgol Bro Dyfrdwy and Karen Evans (Head of Education and Children's Services) regarding this issue, and after discussion, the 5 children have now been accepted into the school. To ensure that this does not happen again in the future, the County will have to re-review the admissions policy for Ysgol Bro Dyfrdwy to ensure priority is given to Llandrillo and Cynwyd pupils.
- **Additional name on the War Memorial** - The clerk is still awaiting a statement from the War Memorial / British Legion before responding to Mr E Roberts' request to add another name to the memorial. In the meantime, Mr Roberts has contacted the Council expressing his disappointment at the lack of contact between us regarding the matter. The clerk to follow up the information required as a matter of urgency by the next meeting.

- **Paint the Bus Shelter (opposite the Berwyn Restaurant)** – the Urrdd/Youth club are willing to paint the bus shelter. Community Council to foot the bill.
- **Tyddyn Llan hedge bordering B4401 over grown** – the clerk has written to the proprietors of Tyddyn Llan. Clerk to also contact Denbighshire CC.
- Tree at Bro Dinam – still no action taken. Dangerous. Clerk to contact County again.

5. CORRESPONDENCE

- **Welsh Water** - a letter was received regarding the interruption of water supply to the village. The pipes to the village are one of the main investments by the Water Board during the next financial period 2020-25.
- **Capel Hananeel** – a second letter received from a member of the chapel asking for contribution towards the renovation of the chapel. Unfortunately, as stated previously, Town and community councils cannot donate to places of Worship as stated in the Local Government Act 1994. Clerk to write to the members of the chapel committee explaining this.
